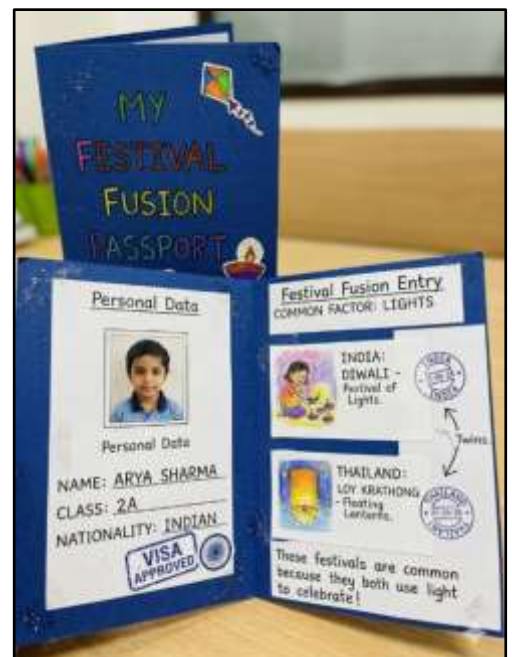
TASK 3: 🌐 My Festival Fusion Passport

Reference: English MCB 'Beyond Words'- Pages 28 & 29

Material required: 1 coloured A4 sheet, 1 white A4 sheet, scissors, glue and markers.

Steps:

- **Fold & Name:** Fold the coloured sheet in half. Write "MY FESTIVAL FUSION PASSPORT" on the front side.
- **ID Page:** Inside the left cover, paste your photo and write your name, class, section and nationality.
- **The "Fusion" Entries (The Main Task)**
Open your English MCB- Pg 28 and 29.



You will find festivals that are "twins."

Heading: Write the "**Common Factor**"

(e.g., kites, water, or lights).

The Pair: Mention the Indian festival and its Foreign twin from the book.

The Description: Write 2 simple sentences explaining why they are similar.

Example:

Common Factor: Kites 🪁

Festivals: Makar Sankranti (India) &

The Bermuda Kite Flying Festival (UK).

Observation: "Both festivals fill the sky with beautiful colours. People feel happy watching the kites fly high!"

- **Stamp it:** Draw a small circle at the bottom of each page and write the country names. (e.g. India, UK, Thailand).

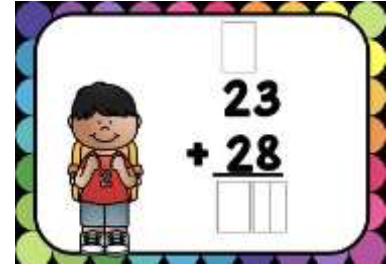

Instructions:

Paste or draw the calendar clearly on the A4 sheet of the month in which you were born. Circle your birth date with a bright colour. Mark all the Sundays in the calendar using different colour. Also mark any holidays in that month neatly. Decorate the sheet beautifully with colours, stars, balloons, cakes, or birthday-themed drawings. Make your work neat, colourful, and creative.



4) My Smart Money Book

Make a small, colourful handmade booklet with 5 pages and one attractive cover page on the topic “My Smart Money Book .”

Design a beautiful cover page with the title “My Smart Money Book”. Decorate it with drawings of coins, notes, a piggy bank, shopping bags, and other money-related pictures.

Page 1 – Coins and Notes

Draw or paste pictures of different coins and currency notes. Write their names and values neatly (for example: ₹1 coin, ₹2 coin, ₹10 note, ₹50 note, etc.).

Page 2 – Needs and Wants

Divide the page into two sections: Needs and Wants. Draw or paste pictures showing things we need (food, water, books) and things we want (toys, chocolates, video games).

Page 3 – Saving

Write a few lines on the importance of saving money. Draw a piggy bank or savings jar and show how small savings help us in the future.

Page 4 – Shopping Bill

Create a simple shopping bill with 4–5 items such as milk, bread, pencil, fruits, etc. Write their prices and calculate the total amount.

Page 5 – My Saving Goal

Write about your personal saving goal. Example: “I want to save money to buy a storybook or a toy.” Draw the item and mention how much you plan to save.



Make sure each page is neat, colourful, and well decorated with drawings and pictures.
