3. Highlight the following using different colours: Your birthday, School holidays, Sundays, Any special family day

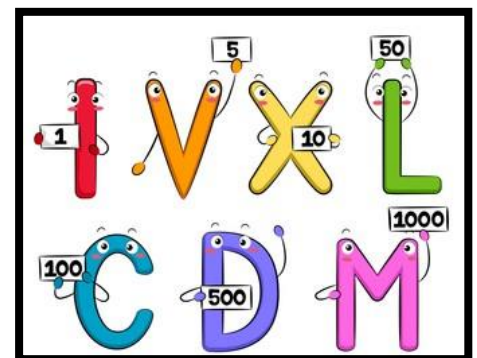
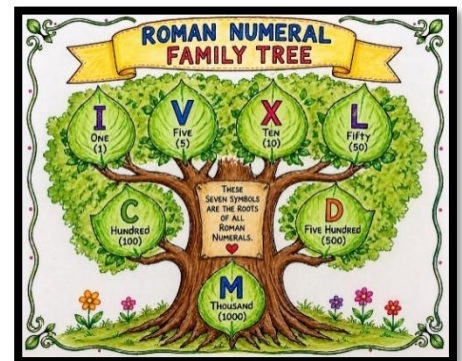
4. Decorate the calendar with: colourful borders, small drawings, stickers or symbols

- Read the labels and use colorful pens to write the following :



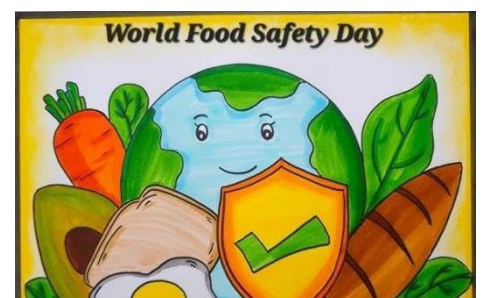
1. **Date of Packaging.**

**Note: The activities should be done in Project File.**



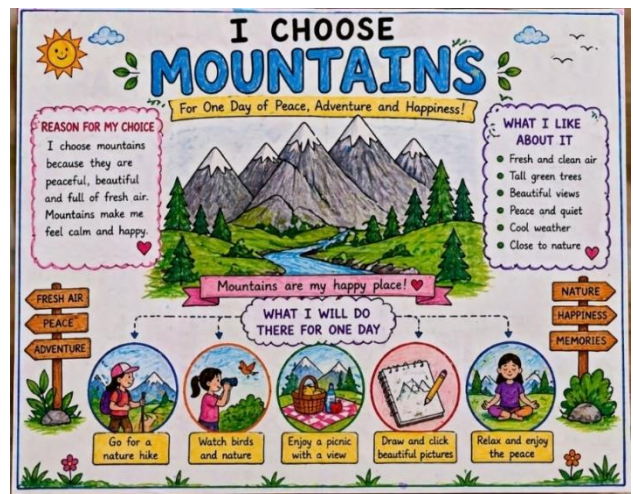
