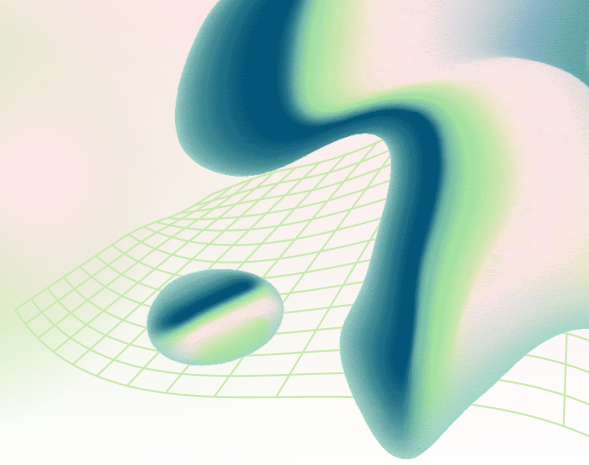


# WINTER HOLIDAY HOMEWORK
