Kindly note that as per order no. DE.15(1025)/PSB/2023/7435-7439 dated 22 August 2023 from the Directorate of Education following are the guidelines of examination and promotions for classes III to V:

**1. There will be two terms for each academic session.**

- First Term will be assessed based on Periodic/Unit Test I and Mid Term Examination.
- Second Term will be assessed based on Periodic/Unit Test II and Annual Examination.

Syllabus for both the terms will be separate. The question papers for the Mid Term Examination will be set out of the syllabus of First Term (Periodic/Unit Test I + Mid Term) and Annual Examination will be held from the syllabus of Second Term(Periodic/Unit Test II and Annual Examination) only.

#### 5. Passing Criteria for class V: The promotion to the next higher class is subject to the condition :

- ❖ A student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied by him/her during the session. He/she must secure overall 33% marks i.e. 33 marks out of 100 [marks of attendance(5 marks) + marks of Subject Enrichment(5 marks) + marks of Project Based Activities(5 marks) + marks of Portfolio(5 marks) + marks of Multiple Assessments(5 marks) + marks of Periodic Assessments(5 marks) + marks of Mid Term Examination(20 marks) + Annual Examination(50 marks) put together]
- ❖ A minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Mid Term Examination + Annual Examination i.e., 18 out of 70 in each subject.
- ❖ Student will not be eligible to appear in Annual Exam, if he/she has not put in at least 75% attendance during the session up to the date of Annual Exam. The attendance for the session will be counted for the working days from the date of admission/first day of the session.
