

## 'Hobbies and creative pursuits are powerful ways to build confidence and help students cope with pressure'

How is your school rising to the challenge of the fast-paced technological changes that are influencing the lives of students?

The school is proactively rising to the challenge of fast-paced technological changes by integrating digital literacy into the daily teaching-learning process. We have equipped the classrooms with smart boards, projectors and internet-enabled systems to make lessons more interactive and engaging. Coding, robotics and digital citizenship are now an integral part of the curriculum.

Reading is vital for mental and academic growth. How do you cultivate love for reading in students?

The mission to promote reading begins with creating a school environment where books are not just read, but treasured. The school boasts a very active central library, which functions as the cornerstone of our reading initiative. Crucially, the Reading Club is a very integral part of the library and daily life, organising activities like author visits and student-led book swaps. We maximise access to books right where students are. We invest heavily in establishing rich class libraries, stocked with diverse, high-interest books. We minimise prescriptive reading lists, prioritising student choice to ensure engagement starts with a book they genuinely want to hold.

Can you suggest some hobbies or creative pursuits that can build confidence in students and help them cope with pressure?

At school, we believe that hobbies and creative pursuits are powerful ways to build confidence and help students cope with pressure. Engaging students in music, dance, art, and creative writing allows them to express emotions that words often cannot. Activities such as robotics, photography, gardening or organis-

Sports and yoga instil discipline, resilience, and the importance of a healthy mind-body balance.

At school, we see these pursuits not as mere extracurricular but as essential companions in shaping balanced, self-assured and emotionally strong individuals.

Regular physical activity is important for students' overall health and academic success. How can a student stay active even with a busy schedule?

Staying physically active is definitely a challenge with a demanding student schedule, but it is totally achievable by integrating movement into daily life. The students can choose the stairs over the elevator or escalator. They can set a timer to take a 5-10-minute break every hour or so, and can use this time for a quick walk outside. Instead of scrolling social media during a long study session break, they should take a brisk 10-15-minute walk to clear their head and boost their focus. The key is often to focus on consistency rather than intensity—even small amounts of





The activity blended art with mathematics while promoting teamwork, creativity, and joyful learning.




## Living the Past: Historical Character Showcase
