EMBRACING LEADERSHIP AND INTEGRITY

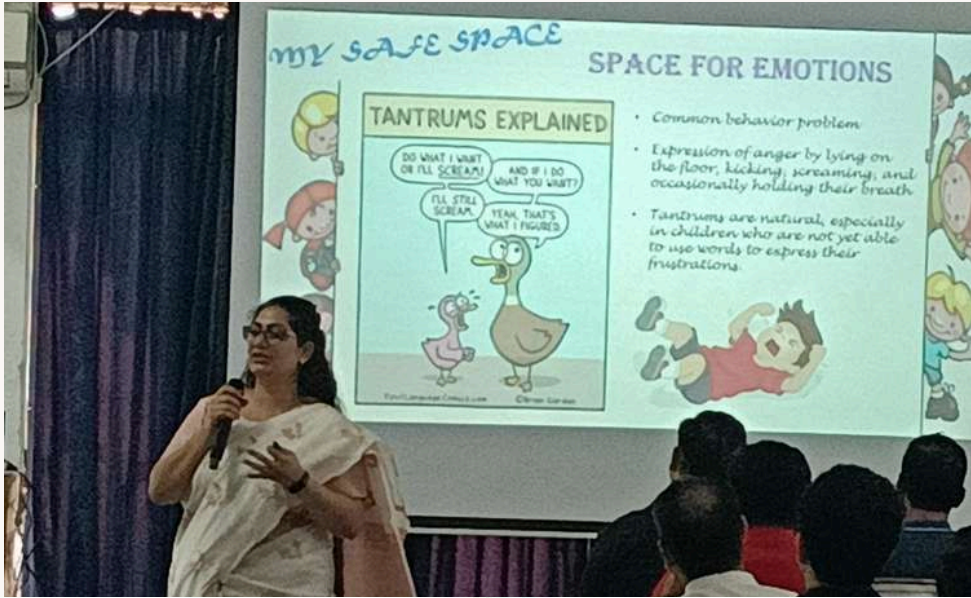

- Skin Safe, Vietnam:** Skin Safe is an AI app that detects skin issues using a smartphone camera, connecting people with reliable skin care service providers.
- MedSOS, Saudi Arabia:** MedSOS is an app that can help in identifying and protecting endangered species by allowing users to report sightings, learn about conservation efforts, and connect with nearby nature reserves all through the use of the camera on their phones and Computer Vision API, Bing Maps API, Azure Notification Hubs, and more.

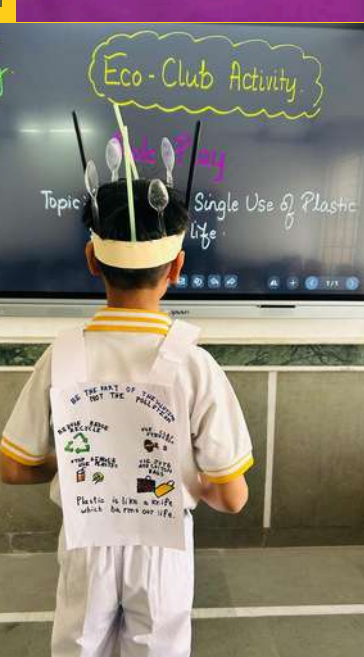


Celebrating Earth Day with a Greener Tomorrow
